Mr., Shellenberger,

Per our phone conversation this morning, here are the lab results from the samples taken on June 8, 2017. I have attached the entire packet of results (C717104A) I received from the state lab. I have also attached (Freya Farms Admin packet) which includes a admin letter letting you know all the product tested needs to be placed on admin hold, a summary of the state lab results, the inventory receipt we used the day we took the samples and the WAC ruling regarding pesticide action levels.

When I asked you this morning about Freya Farms recall plan, you indicated Freya Farms does not have recall plan in place. Per WAC 314-55-225 you are required to have a plan in place. See <http://app.leg.wa.gov/wac/default.aspx?cite=314-55-225> for details. Per WAC 314-55-108 (pesticide action levels provided in attachment) lots or batches that are above the action level are subject to recall.

As we discussed, I would ask that you review the documents and your internal processes to see what lead to these results. I will have to issue a violation notice regarding this investigation. I should have that completed in the next couple of days.
